Ada Moon concert in Altea with the Annetta Nicoli Chair.

**Next Thursday, May 28, at 7:30 p.m., we will listen to his proposal
Animal: a journey between love, fear and other destinations at the
Center for Research in Arts of the UMH.**

Ada Moon returns to the Faculty of Fine Arts of Altea, where she studied, invited by the Annetta Nicoli Chair, to present *Animal: a journey between love, fear and other destinations*. The Murcian composer, producer and singer has established herself as one of the most original and free voices on the contemporary music scene. A multidisciplinary artist, he understands music and image as the same universe, where sound and audiovisual are intertwined in a common narrative. Her work is not defined by labels, but by a constant search: to communicate and share emotions through her own language that draws from hip hop, pop, flamenco and diverse cultural influences.

Her proposal invites the public to a journey that transcends genres and delves into the terrain of the human: love, fear and all those destinies that define us. These are the threads that run through his songs and the concepts that guide his work. From her own experience and that of those around her, she builds stories where life, with all its intensity, becomes the greatest source of inspiration. Her music is a gesture of openness that explores humanity, empathy and the values that unite us, a space for reflection that invites us to look at the other and the world with a renewed perspective. With this gaze – critical, introspective and luminous at the same time – Ada Moon turns creation into an act of love that transcends the personal to become collective.

In addition, at 6:30 p.m. there will be two inaugurations of fourth-year students of the Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts in the same Mascarat building, where they can be visited until June 25. In the Rectangle and El Tossal spaces, the collective exhibition *Final Convergence will be presented*, with a selection of works by the students of the class of 2026 of the Bachelor's Degree in Fine Arts, which highlights the artistic production developed during their years of academic training. The curatorship is the result of the Final Degree Project of the student Alba Andía.

On the other hand, the first exhibition of the PACIC Group will be inaugurated in the Cim room, with the title *Let's do nothing*. It is a collective proposal in which we will find unique and varied pieces in their language, theme and materiality.

The programming of this concert has the collaboration of the City Council of Altea, its Social Welfare Area, the Center for Research in Art (CíA), the Department of Art and the Faculty of Fine Arts of the UMH. All activities are free and with free admission until full capacity is reached, and are aimed at the general public.
